



JVGC Beer-A-Hole League 2026 Rules

1. The Beer-A-Hole League is a 22-week league starting April 15th, 2026, and ends on September 16th, 2026.
 - a. All play will take place on Wednesday afternoons between 3:30pm and 5:30pm. Any players wishing to play outside of this window must make a tee time.
 - b. The mid-season tournament will be played on Wednesday, July 1st, 2026. Teams will be determined by blind draw at 4:30pm with a shotgun start at 5:00pm.
 - c. The season ending tournament will be played on Saturday, September 26th, 2026. Teams will be determined by blind draw at 8:30am with a shotgun start at 9:00am.
2. League dues will be \$60.00. Dues must be paid in full by the fourth week of league. Dues will be used to offset the cost of golf and food during midseason and season-ending tournaments.
 - a. Weekly fees include Green Fees = \$13.00, Cart Fees = \$8.00.
 - b. Event fee is \$5.00 each week. There are optional pins and net skins available at \$2.00 each.
3. Format: 9-holes, play your own ball. Modified Stableford Scoring. Lift, Clean, and Place from any position, 1-club length from any position so long as the playing surface is not changed (cannot move from rough to fairway, or fairway to green). No mulligans at any point during play.
 - a. Stableford points as such: Double Bogey = 1pt, Bogey = 2pt, Par = 3pt, Birdie = 4pt, Eagle or better = 5pt.
 - b. Partners will be selected by blind draw each week and prizes will be awarded to 1st-3rd plus last place based on combined team scoring. All ties broken by the USGA tie-breaking method.
 - c. If there are an odd number of players, one person will be drawn on 2 separate teams.
4. Senior Tees (gold tees) may be used by players 62 years of age or older and Super Senior Tees (silver tees) may be used by players aged 75 years of age and older. However, you may not switch tee markers in the middle of the season. Please designate to the Pro Shop which tees you will play at the beginning of the season.
5. Handicaps will be based on your scoring average relative to par, cut at 90%.
6. Players may not turn in a scorecard for a round played without a witness. Your witness does not have to be a player in the league; and if you need someone to play with, the Pro Shop can help you find a playing partner.
7. Players are also asked to play in groups of 4 or less. Please do not play in larger groups without first acquiring permission from the Pro Shop.
8. All play must start on either tee #1 or #10. No jumping holes without permission from the Pro Shop.
