



JVGC Monday Night Ladies Scramble League 2026 Rules



The Monday Night Ladies League is a 2-Person Scramble League where teams may choose to play at any time of day. The scoring format utilizes a one-day handicapping system which allows the league to remain competitive across skill levels.

1. The JVGC Ladies Scramble League will be a 2-person scramble league. Play will be 9-holes occurring **ONLY** on Mondays. This league will play on the opposite side of the golf course to the Men's Monday Night Scramble League.
 - a. League will take place for 18 weeks starting on May 4th, 2026 and ending on September 14th, 2026.
 - b. League will not be played on Memorial Day (5/25/2026) or Labor Day (9/7/2026).
 - c. Weekly League Fees: \$30.00 (\$13.00 greens, \$8.00 carts, \$9.00 prizes)
2. Teams may play at any time during the day on Mondays provided they have a tee time. The course will block a small window of tee times from 4:00pm-5:00pm.
3. You will not be required to play with another twosome during your league round. However, it is strongly recommended that you have a witness for your league round. Non-league players can serve as witnesses to league play.
 - a. Any player can serve as a substitute for this league.
 - b. If you cannot find a substitute, you may play the round by yourself. In this case, you will play your own ball and can take 1 mulligan, anywhere, on each hole.
4. Normal Scramble Rules apply. The USGA does not govern scramble play, which means that you may lift, clean, and place from anywhere provided you do not change the actual condition of your lie. (A ball in the rough, stays in the rough. A ball in the fairway, stays in the fairway, etc.)
 - a. For scoring, the Pro Shop will employ a same-day handicapping system called System 36. In this format, players receive points for their scores on each hole. Those points are then subtracted from 18 two determine a 9-hole handicap for the day.
 - i. Birdie or better = 2 points
 - ii. Par = 1 points
 - iii. Bogey = 1 points
 - iv. Double bogey or worse = 0 points.
 - v. Triple bogey or worse = (-)2 points
5. Prizes will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place; gross and net.
 - a. Gross prizes awarded first; if a team places in the gross division, they are not eligible for net prizes.
 - b. Pro Shop reserves the right to adjust number of places paid out based on # of participants
 - c. There will be 2 pin prizes each week. 1 will be paid out to a winner in cash, the other in Pro Shop Credit.
 - d. *New to 2026* The league fee each week now includes a gross skins game.
